Announcement of Faculty Position Faculty of Transdisciplinary Sciences for Innovation (Data-Driven Social Systems), Kanazawa University

1. Number of Positions:

One position: Professor, Associate Professor, Lecturer or Assistant Professor

2. Affiliation: Faculty of Transdisciplinary Sciences for Innovation

3. Field of Specialization: Data-Driven Social Systems

4. Duties and Responsibilities: Kanazawa University promotes transdisciplinary research that integrates the humanities, sciences, and medicine within its Faculty of Transdisciplinary Sciences for Innovation. To further strengthen these efforts, we invite applications for a faculty position in Data-Driven Social Systems. The successful candidate will be responsible for research and education in one or more of the following areas: the design and development of data infrastructure; causal inference and evaluation; and implementation and operations. The appointee is also expected to advance research on the design, intervention, and evaluation of social and economic systems, and to teach courses in related areas, which may include regional economic development, industrial policy, and public services.

(1) Class duties:

Undergraduate specialized education (College of Transdisciplinary Sciences for Innovation), Graduate specialized education (Division of Convergence Science, Graduate School of Frontier Science Initiative):

Courses related to the above fields of expertise, as well as courses required in the College of Transdisciplinary Sciences for Innovation and Division of Convergence Science, Graduate School of Frontier Science Initiative curriculum. Our university provides transdisciplinary education integrating humanities, sciences, and medicine and convergent knowledge within the College of Transdisciplinary Sciences for Innovation and Division of Convergence Science, Graduate School of Frontier Science Initiative, and applicants will be responsible for courses related to their field of research. For example, courses related to the above field of expertise, such as "Digital Economy and Regional Expansion," or "Evidence-Based Policy Theory," as well as other courses required by the college and division. The specific courses to be assigned will be decided in consultation with the applicant, taking into consideration their preferences and background.

Notes: Some of the courses listed above may need to be taught in English.

(2) Non-class duties:

Student guidance, supervising research, students' recruitment, admissions, job guidance, social contribution, etc.

- (3) Other necessary duties deemed by the head of the department.
- 5. Employment Status: The employment period is set for 5 years. Candidates may be eligible

for conversion to tenured status until the mandatory retirement age at the end of the fixed term if they meet the prescribed requirements through a reappointment review, based on their achievements during this period.

Re-appointment Performance Review Criteria

- (1) Educational activities: such as lectures, practical training, seminars, research supervision, and student guidance
- (2) Research activities: such as presentations of research papers and conferences
- (3) Research funding and contributions to the university and society

For applicants currently employed at Kanazawa University, the combined duration of the current and any subsequent terms cannot exceed 10 years, which may result in a new employment period of less than 5 years for the new term. Tenured faculty members at Kanazawa University who are hired will be considered as "transferred", without a new fixed term.

6. Qualifications and Requirements: Applicants must meet all of the following requirements

- (1) The applicant must have a doctoral degree (including those who are expected to have a doctoral degree by the time of employment) or have educational and research capabilities equivalent to a doctoral degree.
- (2) The applicant must have outstanding research achievements both domestically and internationally in their respective field and be capable of engaging in education and research activities related to the specified field after joining the position. Additionally, they should demonstrate the ability to collaborate with faculty members for transdisciplinary education and research.
- (3) Nationality is not restricted. It is desirable that applicant possesses the ability to teach and supervise students in both English and Japanese, and to carry out university service (administrative duties) in Japanese.
- (4) The applicant must be able to live in Kanazawa or the surrounding area after being appointed.
- **7. Application deadline:** Must arrive no later than Tuesday, December 9, 2025.
- 8. Scheduled date of hire: April 1, 2026.

9. Documents for submission:

- (1) Curriculum vitae (photo attached, postal code, current address, contact information, educational background from entering university, degrees, professional experience, academic society and activities, rewards and punishments in society)
- (2) List of education and research background (include the field of research, educational experiences and performance, and research papers) (Categorize Research papers such as books, academic papers (note: Write "refereed" for refereed papers), oral presentations, etc.)
- (3) Research activities, educational activities, academic and social activities (within 5 years)
- (4) External funding (Grant-in-Aid for Scientific Research (Kakenhi), commissioned research, joint research, donations, etc.)

- (5) Educational and research aspirations at College of Philosophy in Interdisciplinary Sciences (On a sheet of A4 paper)
- (6) Past research and educational activities and their status (On a sheet of A4 paper)
- (7) Reprints of major papers: (Up to five papers, one copy for each paper, photocopies accepted, A4 size)
- (8) The names and contact information of two referees (On a sheet of A4 paper).

10. Selection Process: After the application screening, an interview and mock class in Japanese or English may be requested.
